Rotarians of District 6200 are seeking outstanding local professionals to visit Southern Chile’ in March 2005 as part of the Group Study Exchange program of The Rotary Foundation.

The purpose of a Group Study Exchange is to promote international understanding and goodwill. While abroad (March 20, 2005 to April 18, 2005), team members will stay in Rotarian’s homes and have the opportunity to meet their vocational and professional counterparts. They will also give presentations to Rotary clubs and other groups about their home country and state.

The Rotary Foundation provides a round-trip air ticket, and local Rotarians in the host country provide meals, lodging and group travel in their district. Team members pay for personal and incidental expenses only.

Anyone interested in applying should be employed full-time in a profession for three to five years. Young professionals within the range of 25 to 40 years of age are encouraged to apply. Applicants must live or be employed in Rotary District 6200, which encompasses southwestern Louisiana plus W. Feliciana, East Baton Rouge and Livingston parishes.
